A Brief History of The Artist, Kenji Babasaki

Mar. 1952 Born in Sasebo C. Nagasaki Pref. Japan

Mar. 1970 Graduated from "Sasebo-kita" High School in Sasebo City
Entered Keio University, Tokyo

May 1974 First visit to India in his undergraduate years

Mar. 1975 Graduated with a bachelor's degree in Faculty of Law & Political Science.

Sep. 1977 Second visit to India

Mar. 1978 Met Champa Tsetan in Dharmasala, India, to whom Kenji had looked up as a mentor not only in painting Tibetan Thangka but also in his artist life . For eleven years from then, Kenji studied under his supervision until his death .

Apr. 1984 Engaged in Teaching on Tibetan Thangka at T.C.C.(Tibetan Culture Center), Tokyo

May 1984 First Private Exhibition held at Sekaikan Gallery, Tokyo. From then exhibitions had been held regulary everyother year until 2014, the16th exhibition. This was the last one ,because the Gallery was closed after The Exhibition.

1989 Champa Tsetan died.
Kenji painted a thangka for the ritual of the deceased teacher. After then he took part in teaching Tibetan

pupils after The Great Teacher.

Apr. 1994 First Book "IKYO" Published from Nichibou Publishing, Tokyo

May 2006 "Thangka", A pictorial and explanations in English Published from the same publisher.

Sep. 2009 Returned to Japan

Jan. 2010 Built a new aterier in his house in Sasebo City Nagasaki Pref. for a new career in Japan.
